





# **Project Timeline**

#### Jul 2023-Oct 2024

Wisconsin spay neuter pilot project

#### Jan 2025

Initial spay neuter accessibility questionnaire collected across 7 Northern Tier States: 192 agencies and vets responded

#### May-June 2025

Analyze survey responses and heat maps of need to establish target areas.

Jun - Dec 2025

Support regional collaborations and grant funds to target areas to improve accessibility

#### Jan 2026

Re-survey northern tier agencies to check progress of accessibility project



# **Wisconsin Pilot Project**

Takeaways – after 15-month project

**35%** reported access to spay neuter services improved.

15% DECREASE in shelters feeling that animals were taking longer to adopt because of access to spay neuter

#### Improved access believed to be from:

"Connections from colleagues in the shelter world"
"Partnerships"

"A low cost spay/neuter team willing to travel to area"
















#### Average time travelled

■ Average number of animals waiting for sterilization by wait time





71.5% have offsite services






## Perception

Canine spay cost




